VISION CASTING: COME & SEE

Always begin by casting a compelling vision of how God wants to impact lostness in your people group.

1/3: REPORT & CELEBRATE

Accountability to one another

Following Jesus

What has God been feeding you from His Word?

How did you obey last week's lesson?

Are you struggling and need prayer?

Fishing for Jesus

Did you share the gospel with lost people?

Did you find a person of peace?

Did you train disciples? Are they training others?

Are you missing opportunities? making excuses?

Worship God and celebrate the work He is doing.

1/3: HEAR & OBEY

1/3: PRACTISE & PRAY

Identify and pray for lost people (People List)

Pray for one another to be bold in witness.

COMMISSIONING: GO & TELL

Restate the vision, then with cheerful expectation send disciples out to obey Jesus.



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
