*Pray like this:*

<b>PRAISE</b>  <b>VERSE 9</b> <i>Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.</i>	What can you say to God about His greatness, the things He has done, or your love for Him?
<b>PURPOSE</b>  <b>VERSE 10</b> <i>Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.</i>	What can you say to God about His Kingdom, His plan for the world, or your part in His work?
<b>PROVISION</b>  <b>VERSE 11</b> <i>Give us this day our daily bread.</i>	What can you say to God about the everyday things you need, or the needs of others?
<b>PARDON</b>  <b>VERSE 12</b> <i>Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.</i>	What can you say to God about your sins, and about your forgiveness of other people?
<b>PROTECTION</b>  <b>VERSE 13</b> <i>And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.</i>	What can you say to God about protecting you from temptation and the influence of Satan?
Include the phrase "In Jesus' name" because Jesus makes possible our connection with God. "Amen" expresses our agreement with God.
